Mumps virus (strain Miyahara vaccine) (MuV) HN Protein, His Tag(HNN-M52H3) is expressed from human 293 cells (HEK293). It contains AA Gly 106 - Thr 582 (Accession # [P11235](#)).

Molecular Characterization

This protein carries a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus.
The protein has a calculated MW of 54.6 kDa. The protein migrates as 66-70 kDa under reducing (R) condition (SDS-PAGE) due to glycosylation.

Endotoxin

Less than 1.0 EU per µg by the LAL method / rFC method.

Purity

>90% as determined by SDS-PAGE.
>90% as determined by SEC-MALS.

Formulation

Lyophilized from 0.22 µm filtered solution in PBS, pH7.4 with trehalose as protectant.

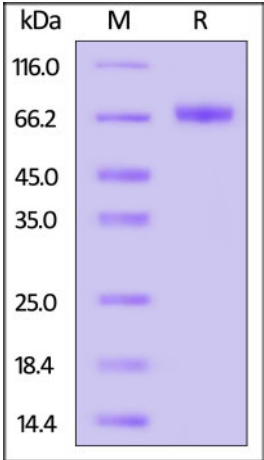

Storage

For long term storage, the product should be stored at lyophilized state at -20°C or lower.
Please avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
This product is stable after storage at:

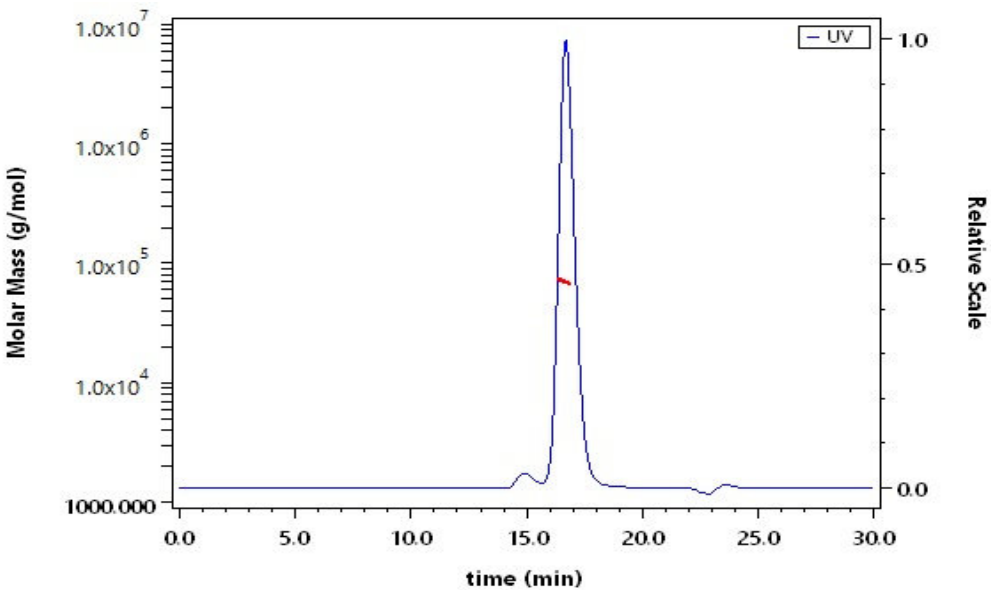
- 20°C to -70°C for 12 months in lyophilized state;
- 70°C for 3 months under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

SEC-MALS

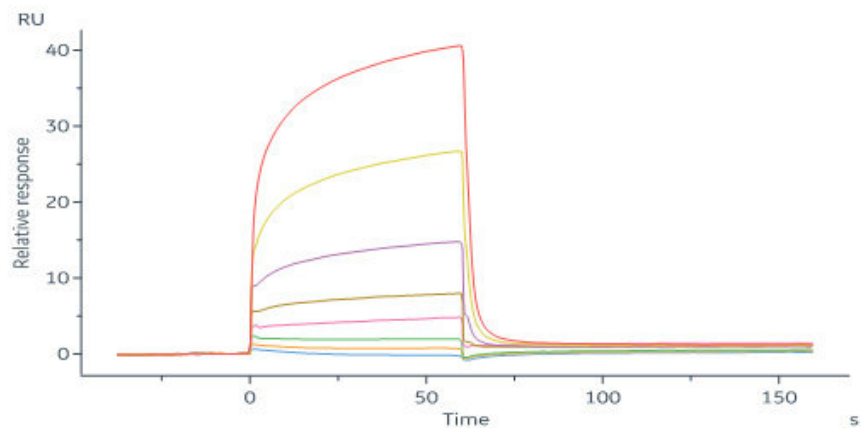

Mumps virus (strain Miyahara vaccine) (MuV) HN Protein, His Tag (Cat. No. HNN-M52H3) immobilized on CM5 Chip can bind 3'-Sialyllactose / GM3 Ganglioside oligosaccharide with an affinity constant of 586 μ M as determined in a SPR assay (Biacore 8K) (QC tested).
