This protein carries a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus.

The protein has a calculated MW of 82.9 kDa. The protein migrates as 95-130 kDa when calibrated against [Star Ribbon Pre-stained Protein Marker](#) under reducing (R) condition (SDS-PAGE) due to glycosylation.

Endotoxin

Less than 1.0 EU per µg by the LAL method / rFC method.

Purity

>95% as determined by SDS-PAGE.

Formulation

Lyophilized from 0.22 µm filtered solution in PBS, pH7.4 with trehalose as protectant.

Please avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

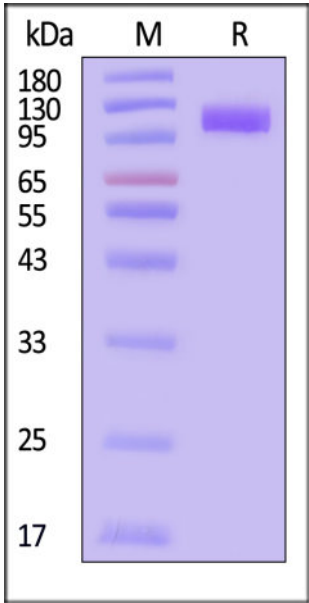
This product is stable after storage at:

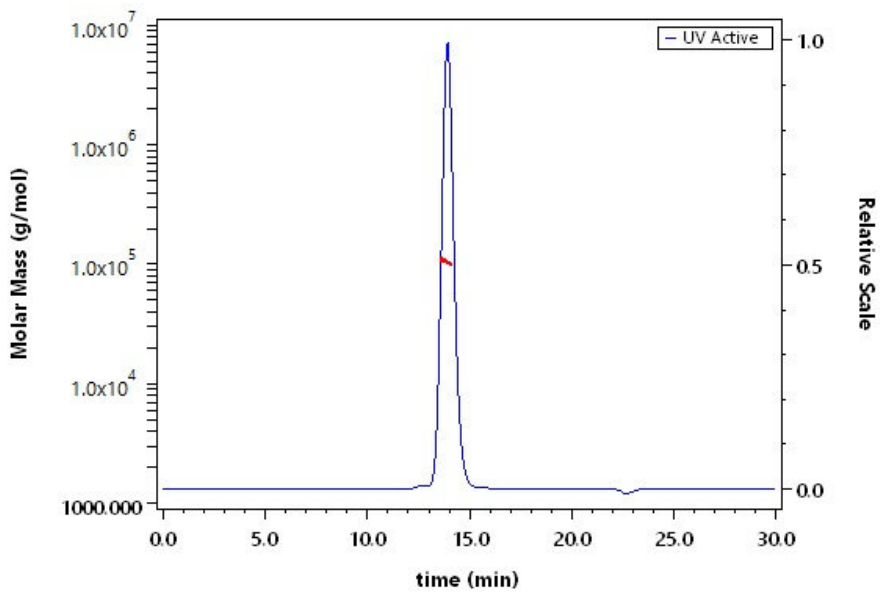

SDS-PAGE



Rat OSMR beta Protein, His Tag on SDS-PAGE under reducing (R) condition. The gel was stained with Coomassie Blue. The purity of the protein is greater than 95% (With [Star Ribbon Pre-stained Protein Marker](#)).

SEC-MALS



The purity of Rat OSMR beta Protein, His Tag (Cat. No. OSR-R52H4) is more than 95% and the molecular weight of this protein is around 90-120 kDa verified by SEC-MALS.

Background

Oncostatin-M-specific receptor subunit beta (OSMR β), also known as Interleukin-31 receptor subunit beta (IL-31RB), is the beta subunit of the type II OSM receptor, which is a heterodimer of gp130 and OSMR β . OSMR β associates with the low-affinity OSM·gp130 complex to form a high-affinity heterodimeric receptor that is capable of transducing OSM-specific signaling events.
